5. Insurance

To ensure you have taken advice on adequate insurance cover whilst undertaking voluntary work approved and authorised by Rory's Well.

6. Equal opportunities

To ensure that each volunteer is treated in accordance with the equal opportunities policy; a copy of which is set out in the Rory's Well policies
